

Chairman's Report

2009 is a joyful year for Wah Yan as it is the 90th Anniversary of Wah Yan Hong Kong and the 85th anniversary of Wah Yan Kowloon. The two schools have joined hands to organize a series of activities including a Walkathon, a Gratitude Dinner and Wah Yan Encore to mark the occasion.

This year is also the 40th Anniversary of the incorporation of the Wah Yan (Hong Kong) Past Students Association (PSA) as a limited company in 1969. The PSA has organized a lot of activities for the past students. With the inauguration of the Medical, Legal and Finance Fraternities within the year, we have a much stronger tie of our Wahyanites within different professional fields. Below are some of the major events of the year.

AGM 2009: The AGM and the 40th Anniversary celebration dinner were held on 29 June 2009.

Wah Yan Walkathon 2009 "Pace with Love": On 18th October, 2009, almost 1,800 past or current students, teachers, staff and their families and friends helped us kick off the 85th and 90th anniversaries celebrations of Wah Yan College Kowloon and Hong Kong respectively. Hon. Donald Tsang, Chief Executive, with other guests officiated the opening ceremony.

Wah Yan Anniversary Gratitude Dinner: The Gratitude Dinner held in the Grand Hall of Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre on 13 December 2009 was another function to celebrate the anniversaries of the two schools. Around 1,500 participants attended. An amount of more than \$1.6 million was raised.

Wah Yan Encore: The finale of our celebration programme, Wah Yan Encore, will be held on Saturday, 10th July 2010 at the Hong Kong Coliseum. It will showcase the essence of performing arts emerged in the histories of Wah Yan. More than 800 alumni, teachers, parents, current students and our friendly schools will be performing. Come join us.

Cantonese Opera in English: To celebrate Wah Yan Hong Kong's 90th Anniversary and to raise fund for the School Development Project, the Wah Yan Dramatic Society had put on two performances of "A Lizard Is No Dragon" a Cantonese opera sung in English on 22 and 23 October, 2009 at the Drama Theatre, The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts.

Students of the Year (SOY) & Student Ambassador Scheme: The three Students Of the Year (SOY) were Cheung Ka Ho David (6S1), Fung Cheuk Yin (6S2) and Li Ting Hong Standford (6S1), and Fung Cheuk Yin was elected Student Ambassador, who will represent the association to visit our Southern California Chapter later this year.

Finally, to strengthen communication between the association and its members, PSA newsletters called 'Wahyanites' are published regularly. In addition, a group called 'Wah Yan College Hong Kong Past Student Association' has been created in Facebook. We have also helped registering Wah Yan College, Hong Kong in Facebook. Users are now able to input their Form 5 graduation year to locate their classmates there (the most senior registered user graduated in 1950!).
